Our water resources are under increasing pressure, and we need to improve the way that we use and manage our water resources to ensure a safe and adequate supply for future generations.

The Carrot River Valley Watershed Association (CRVWA) is your local voice on watershed issues in our area. We are your neighbors and partners in protecting our ground and surface water resources. Membership Benefits:

- The CRVWA is a grassroots, non-profit organization working locally for the benefit of our watershed and all of its citizens.
- Members are recognized in our quarterly newsletter (*CRVWA Water Source*) which is distributed throughout our watershed with the NorthEast Sun, is available on our website (www.crvwatershed.ca), and is e-mailed directly to members, partners, and other watershed groups throughout the province.
- Members assist in charting the direction of the CRVWA by identifying potential projects, topics of concern, problems and potential solutions.
- Members have voting privileges at the CRVWA Annual General Meeting, and their appointed representative can be elected to the CRVWA Board of Directors.
- Members have a position and voting privileges on their local Watershed Advisory Committee. There are 3 Watershed Advisory Committees: Carrot River East, Carrot River West, and Lenore Lake Basin.
- We are working to implement the Source Water Protection Plan's 83 key actions to manage and protect drinking and source water and watershed resources for now and future generations.
- We assist members with project planning; access to funding, grants, and programming; identifying potential projects; and accessing technical support for projects that directly impact our watershed.
- Membership fees are used locally for the benefit of our watershed.
- We administer the Carrot River Watershed Agri-Environmental Group Plan and employ a local technician to help producers implement and receive funding for Beneficial Management Practices (BMPs) on their farms through the Farm Stewardship Program and Farm & Ranch Water Infrastructure Program.
- We work with local schools on youth education projects including the Burger & Fries Farm, watershed education, poster contests and more.
